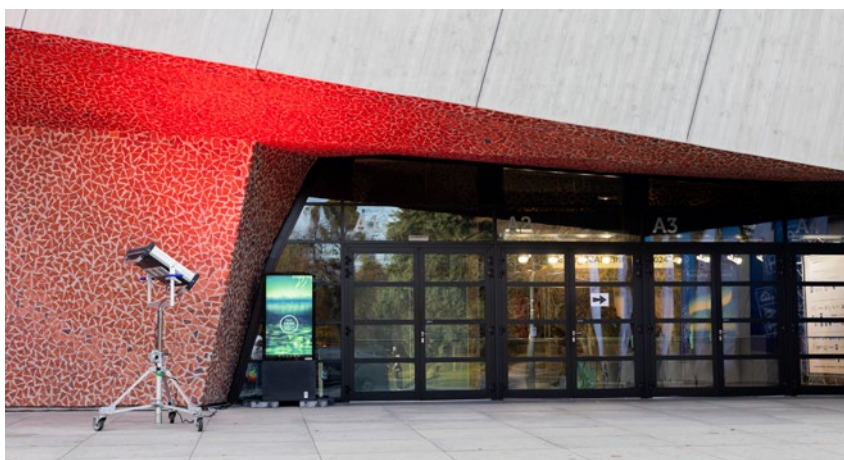

1. GENERAL INFORMATION ABOUT THE BUILDING

The Festival Centre has 3 widely accessible levels. Each of them can be accessed by elevators located inside the building. The exception is level -2 where the Press Conference Room is located (more information on access to the Press Conference Room can be found in point 3.2).

Assistance dogs are allowed in the Festival Centre.

1.1 ENTRANCE

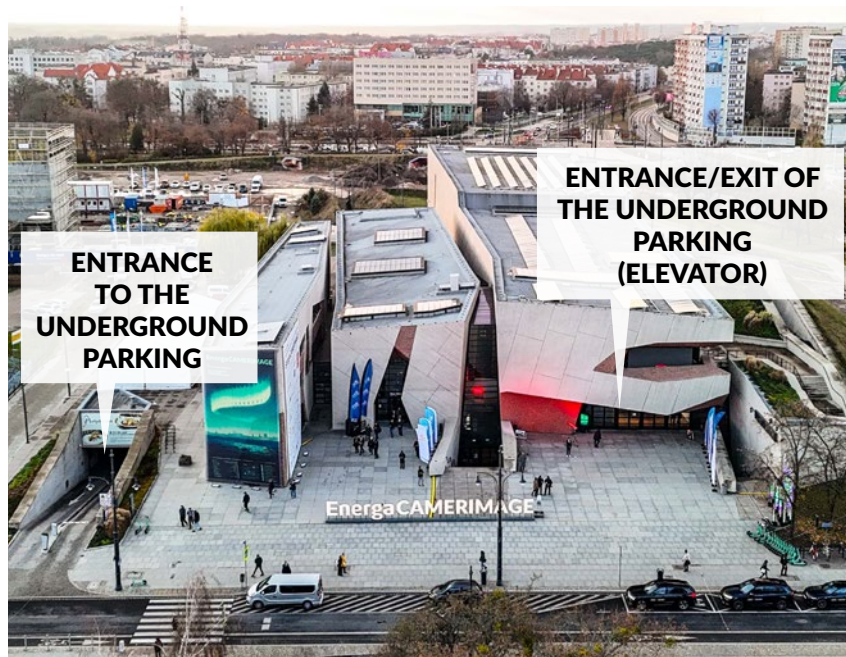
Main entrance can be accessed from Aleja Solidarności. **There are no entrance stairs. The entrance does not have automatic door.**

1.2 CAR PARK

Car park entrance/exit is located on Aleja Solidarności. Underground car park contains **5 spaces** for people with disabilities and/or their assistants. Parking fee is required. Entrance to the underground car park is located on the left side of the Festival Centre.

NOTE: From the car park level, access via elevator (elevator dimensions) and the adjacent staircase (number of steps) leads outside (level 0). From there, one needs to go to the Main Entrance.

2.1 RECEPTION DESK AND FESTIVAL CENTRE AREA ENTRANCE

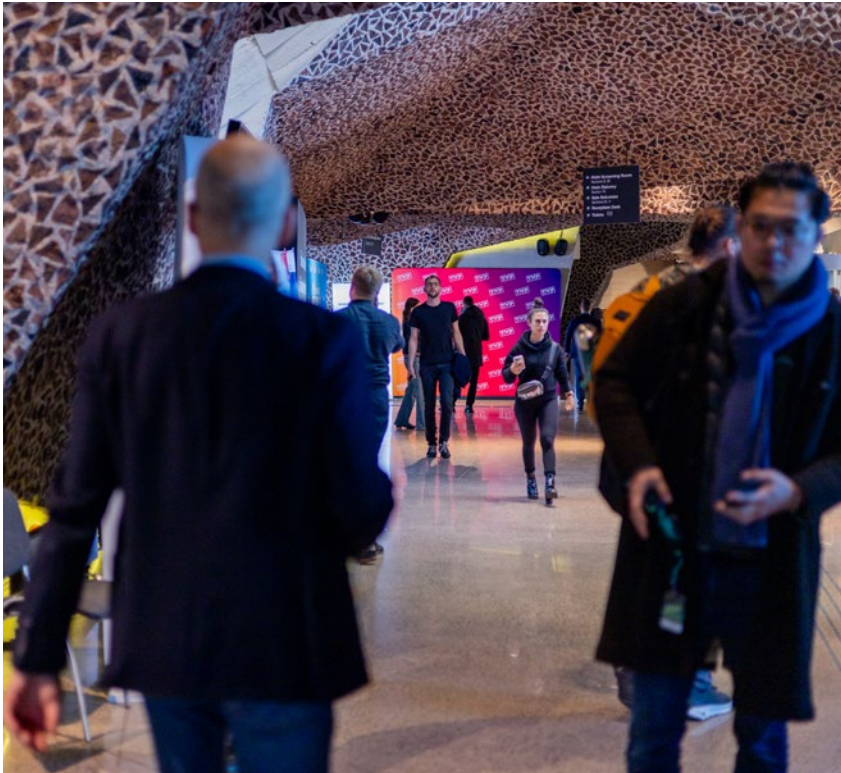

Additionally, right in front of the Main Entrance, alongside Aleja Solidarności, 3 public short-term „kiss and ride” parking spaces are available.

1.3 GENERAL DESCRIPTION OF COMMUNICATION ROUTES - CORRIDORS, STAIRS, ELEVATORS

Horizontal circulation leads through long and wide corridors, enabling comfortable and safe movement. The exceptions are the Seminar Room and the Canteen, accessed via long and narrow corridor.

Vertical circulation between all levels of the Centre (from -2 to +1) is supported by appropriately sized elevators equipped with a voice announcement system (available only in Polish).

There are two public elevators in CKK Jordanki. One is located in the main foyer of the Festival Centre, while the other, located outside the venue, provides access to the car park.

The elevators' controls are easily accessible and facilitated by raised buttons with numbering additionally marked in Braille.

Access to level -1, which includes the ToruńCAMERIMAGE Market, Press Conference Room, Seminar Room and Canteen, is possible via two staircases (28 i 30 steps) and an elevator (110 x 150 cm).

Access to level 1, which includes the Entrance to the Main Screening Room Balcony, is possible via a staircase (37 steps) and an elevator (160 x 160 cm).

If you need additional help moving around the building, please contact the volunteers or the Reception Desk. The volunteers know the building well and can help guide you.

1.4 TOILETS (LEVELS 0,-1, +1)

Toilets for people with disabilities are available on **each level of the foyer**. The entrances to the toilets are marked accordingly. The toilets' doors open outwards.

The toilets on level 0 are located next to the cloakroom, to the right.

Toilets on level -1 are located at the back of the foyer, near the Welcome Pack Pick-Up Point and in the corridor leading to the Seminar Room and the Canteen (opposite the entrance to the Seminar Room).

Toilets on level +1 are located opposite the entrance to the Main Balcony.

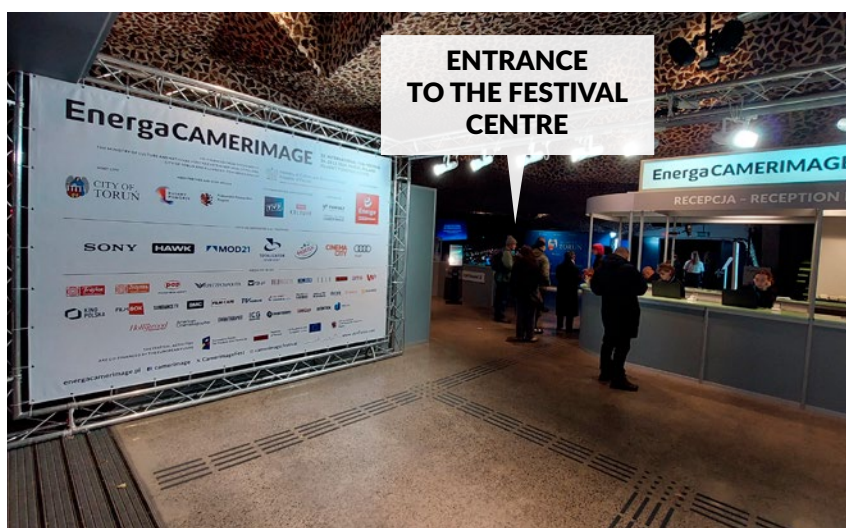
1.5 CLOAKROOMS (LEVELS 0, -1)

There are two cloakrooms in the building. The first one is located on level 0, behind the Reception Desk, on the right side of the foyer.

The second cloakroom is located on level -1, to the right of the elevator leading from levels 0 and +1.

2. LEVEL 0

The entrance and exit to the Festival Centre are located on level 0, as well as: Reception Desk, Cloakroom, toilets, entrance to the Main Screening Room (not wheelchair accessible), Festival Shop, Food Stand and entrance to the Artystyczna Restaurant.

Reception Desk is located at the main entrance. At the Reception Desk, one can collect an entry card, book a seat at an event (depending on availability) and get information.

Everyone entering the Festival Centre needs to pass through the entrance located at the left of the Reception Desk, where they electronically mark their entry to the facility (a physical identifier placed on the reader, a QR code available in the participant's Festival application or a ticket in physical form or on a mobile device).

Holders of entry cards, tickets for screenings taking place on the current day at the Center, or tickets granting entry to the Festival Center valid for the current day are entitled to access the Festival Center.

2.2 MAIN SCREENING ROOM ENTRANCES

Two entrances to the Main Screening Room are located on level 0.

The door to the main entrance is located right behind the Reception Desk.

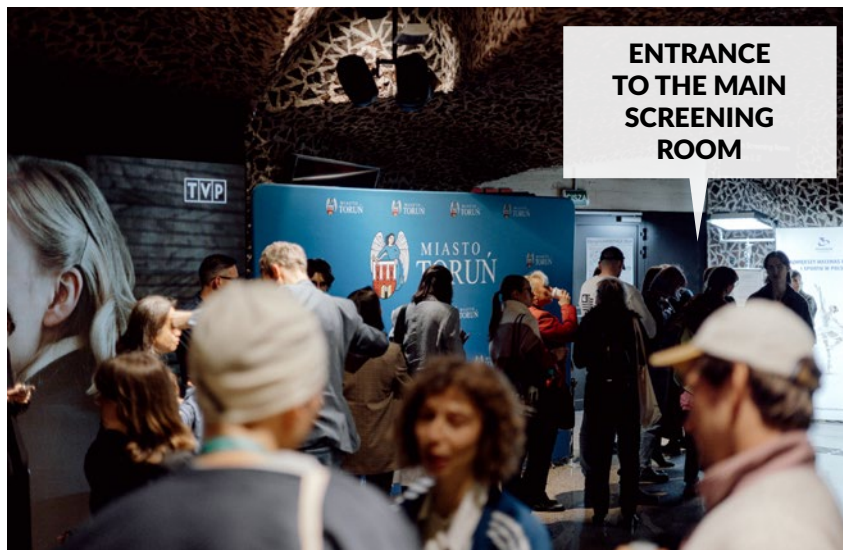
The second entrance is located on the same level and leads to side balcony (sectors IV and V). The passage is located on the right side of the Reception Desk, next to the cloakroom.

People with limited mobility are advised not to enter the Main Screening Room from level 0 due to the stairs leading to certain rows. The entrance is only possible from level -1.

Complete information on the Main Screening Room accessibility from all levels can be found in point 5 of this document.

2.3 FOOD STAND AND ARTYSTYCZNA RESTAURANT

A small food stand serving snacks and beverages is located to the right of the foyer.

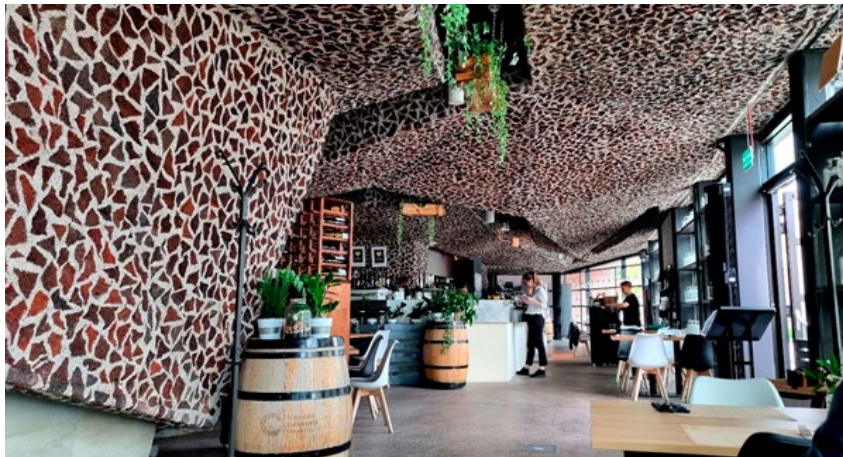

The stand is located right next to Artystyczna Restaurant.

The door leading to the Restaurant remains open during the Festival and there are no stairs. Toilets in the restaurant are adjusted to the needs of people with limited mobility.

The restaurant can be entered from outside the building. The door is located on the left, behind the underground car park entrance.

2.4 FESTIVAL SHOP AND EXIT

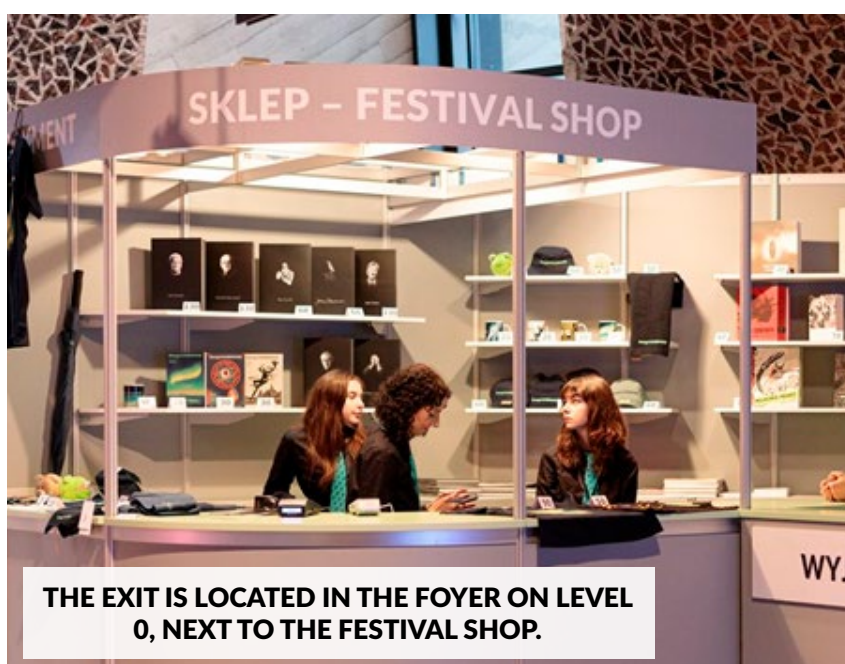

The Festival Shop is located on the left side of the foyer, in front of the Food Stand.

The Shop offers Festival merchandise and publications.

The exit is located on the right side of the Shop. Everyone leaving the Festival Centre passes through the exit gate, where they electronically mark their exit from the facility (a physical ID placed on the reader, a QR code available in the participant's festival app, or a ticket for a single screening).

3. LEVEL -1

The following are located on level -1: Press Office, Press Conference Room, Coffee Stand, Welcome Pack Pick-Up Point, Main Screening Room entrances adjusted to the needs of people with limited mobility, ToruńCAMERIMAGE Market, Seminar Room, Canteen and Festival Organizers' Offices.

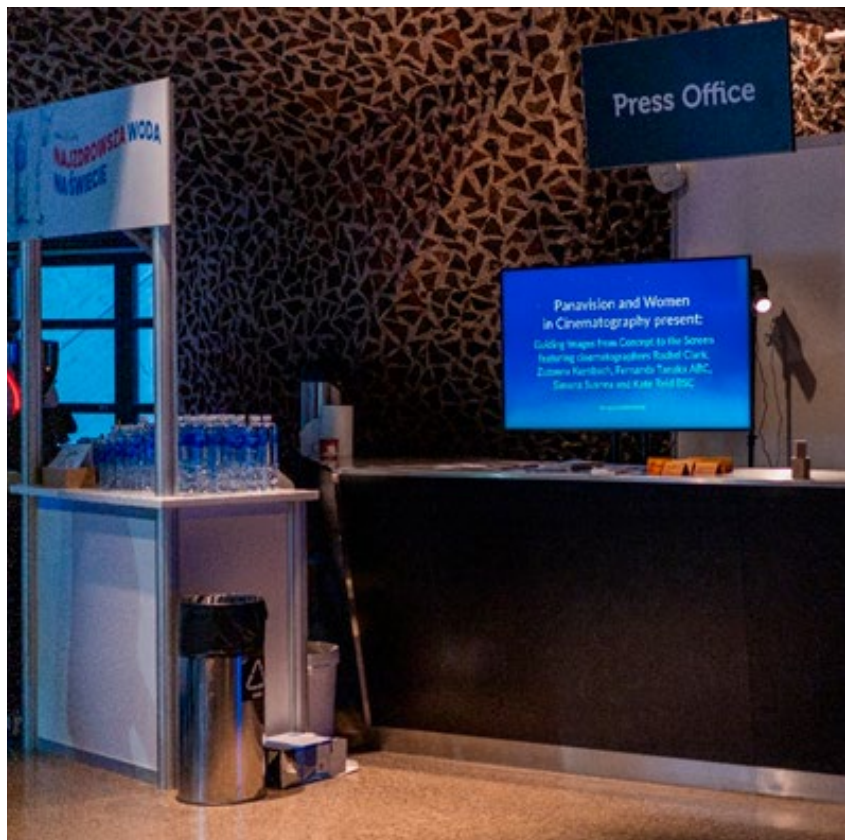
Entering from the level 0 is possible via:

- **stairs located on the left of the foyer, next to the Artystyczna Restaurant (28 steps),**
- **stairs located on the right of the foyer, next to the Reception Desk (30 steps),**
- **an elevator in the foyer (110 x 150 cm).**

3.1 PRESS OFFICE

Press Office is located in front of the main entrance to the ToruńCAMERIMAGE Market. At the Press Office, Festival participants can find information about the current Festival program.

3.2 PRESS CONFERENCE ROOM (LEVEL -2)

To the right of the Press Office there is a passage to the Press Conference Room (corridor under the staircase).

The room is located on level -2. The stairs leading to the level -2 are steep (53 steps).

NOTE: accessing the Conference Room without using stairs is possible with an elevator, different than the public elevator located in the foyer. To use the elevator

leading to the Conference Room, please contact the organizers at access@camerimage.pl.

There are no stairs at the seating level in the Press Conference Room. The chairs are movable and can be removed for wheelchair users. Our volunteers are present in the Room during every event and you can ask them for help at any time.

3.3 COFFEE STAND

The Coffee Stand is located in the foyer on level -1, right next to the Press Office, opposite the entrance to the ToruńCAMERIMAGE Market.



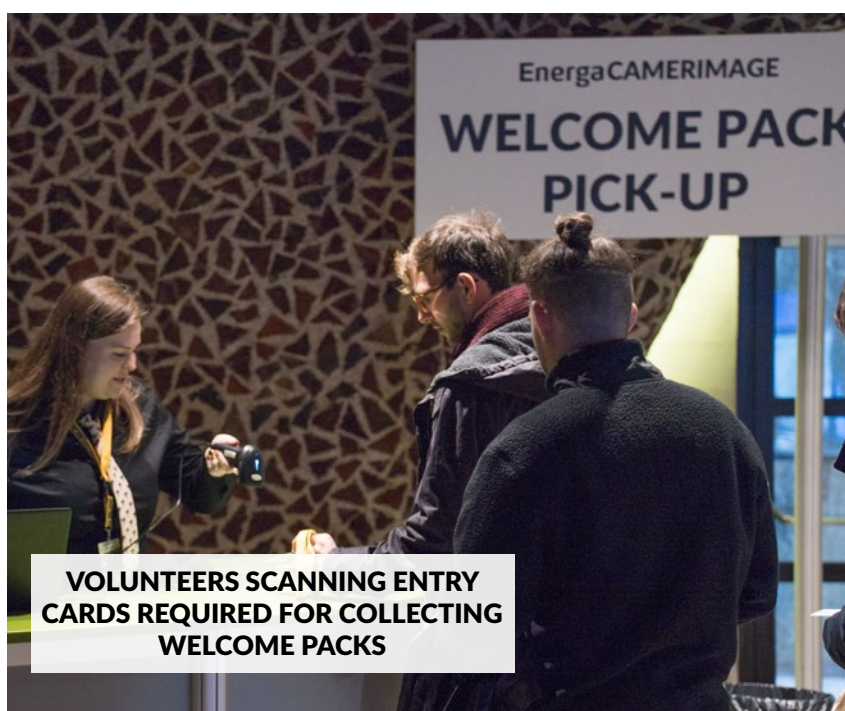

3.4 WELCOME PACK PICK-UP POINT

3.5 ENTRANCES TO THE MAIN SCREENING ROOMS (ACCESS FOR WHEELCHAIR USERS AND PEOPLE WITH LIMITED MOBILITY)

There are two entrances to the Main Hall on level -1, **both of which lead to areas adapted to the needs of people with limited mobility, including wheelchair users.**

The first entrance is located next to the staircase leading to the level -1 from the Reception Desk, right next to the Welcome Pack Pick-Up Point. This is the most convenient access point for wheelchair users leading directly to designated areas.

The second entrance is located in the connector separating ToruńCAMERIMAGE Market from the Main Hall.

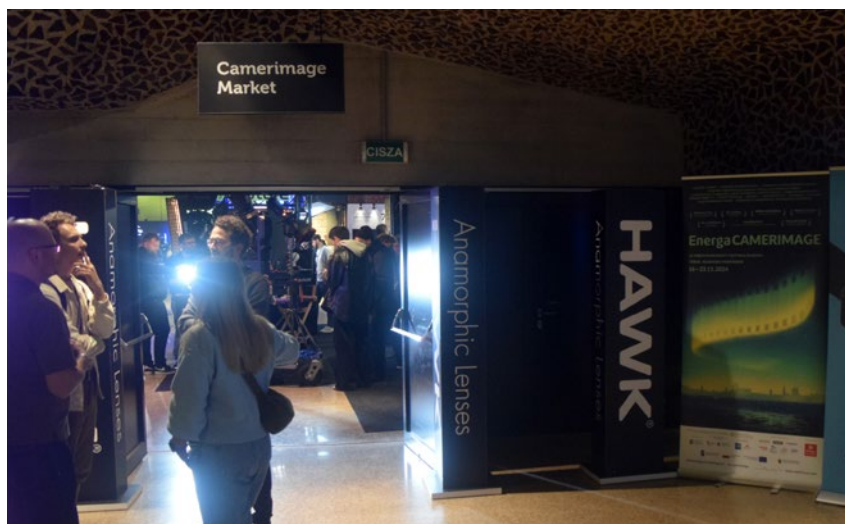
Seats for people with limited mobility are located in the first row of sector III.

Please let our team know beforehand in order reserve a suitable seat for a person with disability and/or their assistant after booking a seat for a given event at access@camerimage.pl by 16:00 one day before your planned visit.

Complete information about the access to the Main Screening Room from all levels of the Festival Centre can be found in point 5 of this document.

3.6 ToruńCAMERIMAGE MARKET

The main entrance to the ToruńCAMERIMAGE Market is located opposite the staircase leading from the level 0. The stairs are located next to the Artystyczna Restaurant. Opposite to the entrance, the Press Office is located.

This is the main market space. Exhibitors' stands are also located in the foyer on the level -1 and in the connector separating ToruńCAMERIMAGE Market from the Main Screening Room.

Passage through the Market leads also to the Seminar Room and the Canteen.

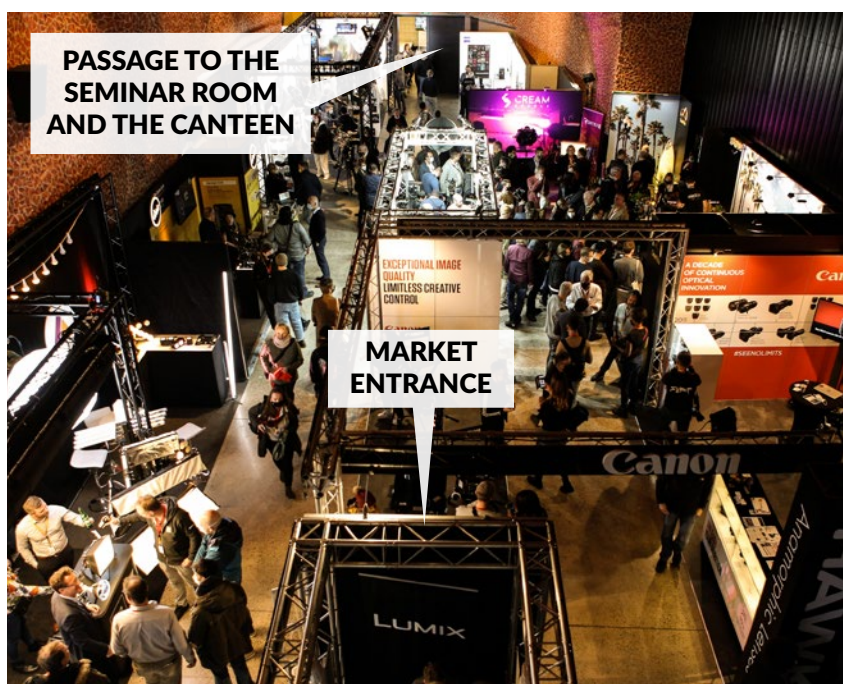

Please mind that the Market space is used by the viewers leaving the Main Screening Room, therefore free movement around the market may be interrupted immediately before and after screenings.

If you need help passing through the Market at that time, please reach out to the volunteers who can be found in every part of the Festival Centre.

3.7 SEMINAR ROOM

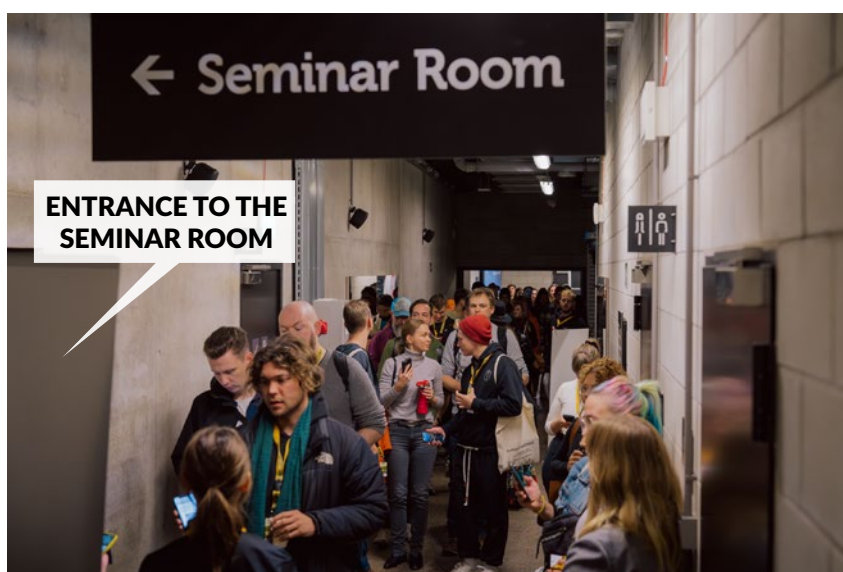

Access to the Seminar Room is possible through the main area of the ToruńCAMERIMAGE Market, then follow the corridor on the right. The corridor leads directly to the Seminar Room. **The corridor is narrow and can get very crowded immediately before and after seminars.** The entrance to the hall is opposite the toilets, on the right.

The Seminar Room has one row of seats accessible without stairs. Access to remaining seats requires using stairs.

Please report the need to reserve an appropriate seat for a person with a disability and/or their assistant to our team after booking a seat for a given event at access@camerimage.pl by 16:00 one day before your planned visit.

3.8 THE CANTEEN

To reach the Canteen, go through the main area of the ToruńCAMERIMAGE Market, follow the corridor on the right and pass next to the Seminar Room. The Canteen is on the right at the end of the corridor.

Please note that right before and after events taking place in the Seminar Room participants gather in the corridor leading to the Canteen, therefore entering the Canteen may be more difficult at that time.

The Canteen is a quick-service bar, where the visitors can purchase hot meals, snacks and beverages.

3.9 FESTIVAL ORGANIZERS' OFFICES

The Festival Organizers' Office Rooms are located in spaces marked as "Dressing Rooms". They are located behind the main part of the ToruńCAMERIMAGE Market, on the left. In front of the office there is a reception desk, where our volunteers can provide you with help or information on how to move around the facility.

4. LEVEL +1

The following are located on level +1: The Balconies of the Main Screening Room, First Aid Point and toilets.

Entering from levels 0 and -1 is possible with:

- **the stairs on the right side of the foyer, next to the Reception Desk (67 steps),**
- **with an elevator in the foyer (160 x 160 cm).**

4.1 ENTRANCE TO THE BALCONIES

On level +1, the entrances to the balconies of the Main Screening Room are located. They are open during the most popular screenings.

There is no access to seats for people with limited mobility from level +1, as stairs lead to all rows. Access is possible only on level -1.

Complete information on Main Screening Room accessibility from all levels can be found in point 5 of this document.

4.2 FIRST AID

To the left of the entrances to the balconies there is a widely accessible First Aid Point, where a medic can provide assistance in emergency situations.

5. THE MAIN SCREENING ROOM (LEVELS -1, 0, +1)

Entering the Main Screening Room is possible from all the publicly accessible levels of the Festival Centre.

Below you can find the description on accessing the Main Screening Room from all levels of the Festival Centre.

Level -1:

- Access via entrance located next to the staircase leading to level -1 from the Reception Desk (sectors II and III), right next to the Welcome Pack Pick-Up Point. **This is the most convenient access point for wheelchair users leading directly to designated seats. Accessing the first row of sector III does not require using stairs,**
- Access through the connector separating ToruńCAMERIMAGE Market from the Main Screening Room (sectors II and III). Accessible for wheelchair users, as reaching the first row of sector III does not require using stairs.

Level 0:

- Access through the door located behind the Reception Desk (sectors II and III). Not accessible for wheelchairs, access to individual rows via stairs,
- Access to the side balcony (sector IV) via passage located next to the cloakroom, on the right side of the foyer (passage without stairs). Not accessible for wheelchairs, access to individual rows via stairs,
- Access to the side balcony (sector V) via the staircase located behind the Reception Desk or from level +1 (level of the main balcony accessible by elevator), access to individual rows via stairs.

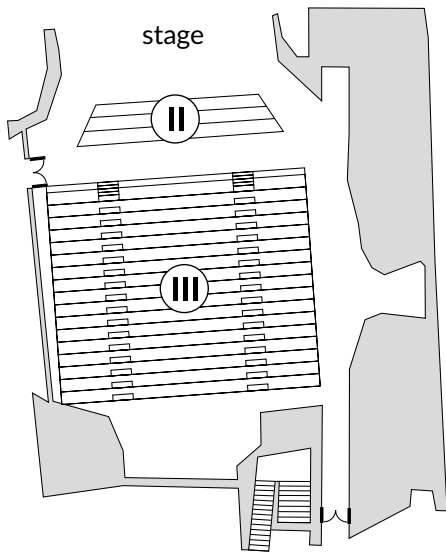
Level 1:

- Access to seats on the main balcony (sector VI), open during selected events, not accessible for wheelchairs, access to individual rows via stairs,
- Access to the side balcony (sector V) via staircase leading down from level 1, access to individual rows is possible via stairs.

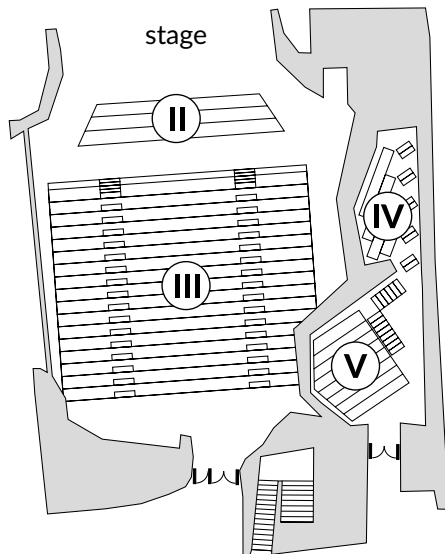

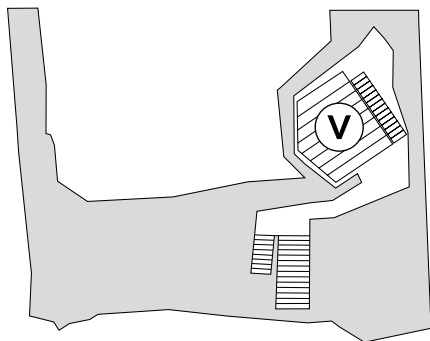
MAIN SCREENING ROOM PLAN WITH SECTORS



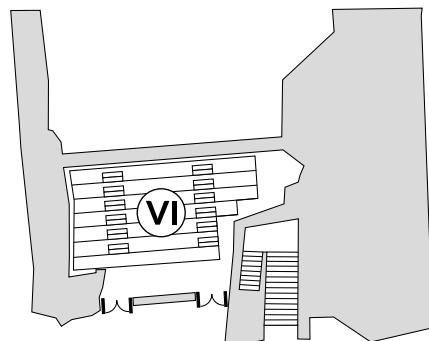
sectors accessible from **level -1**

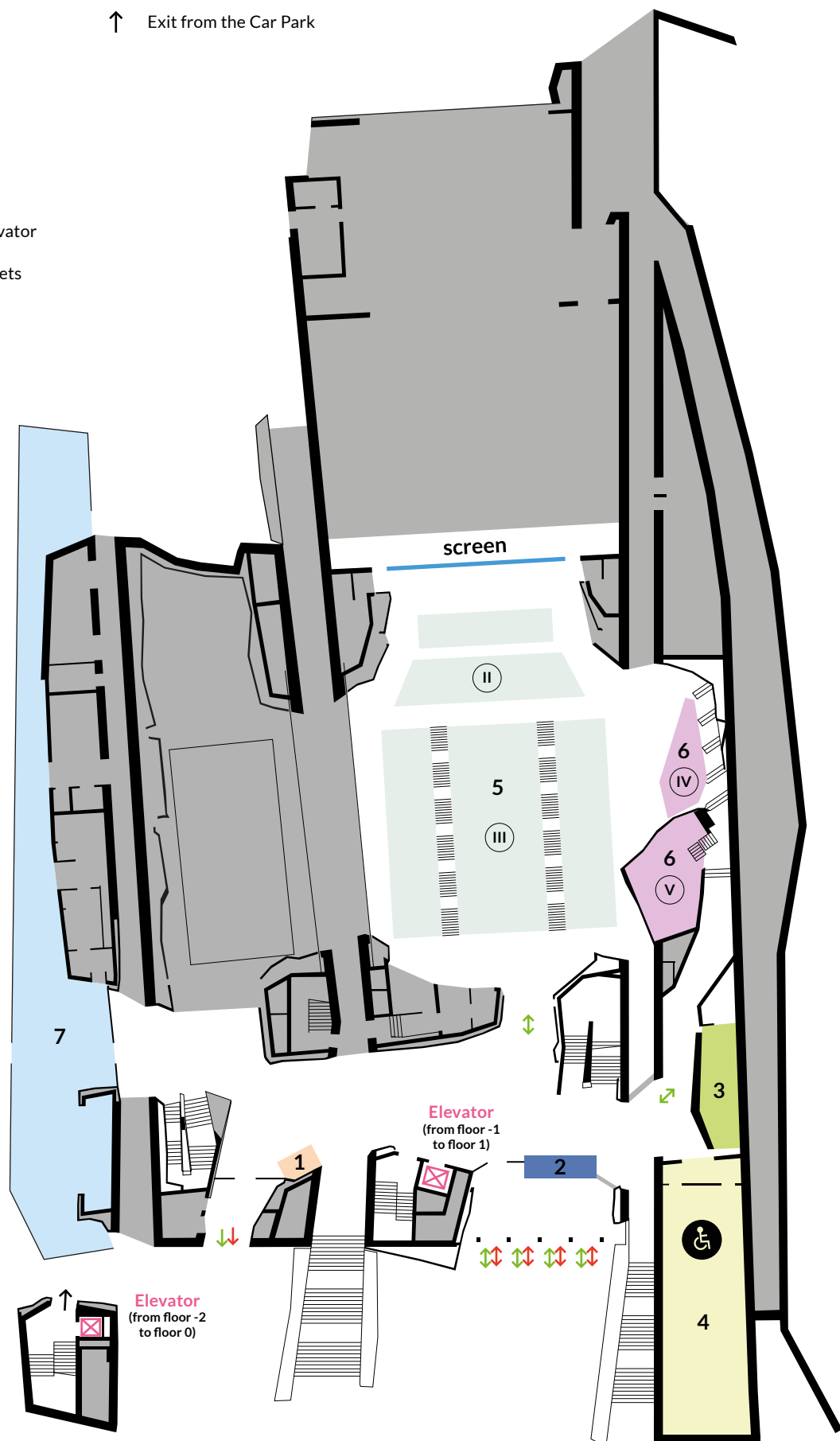

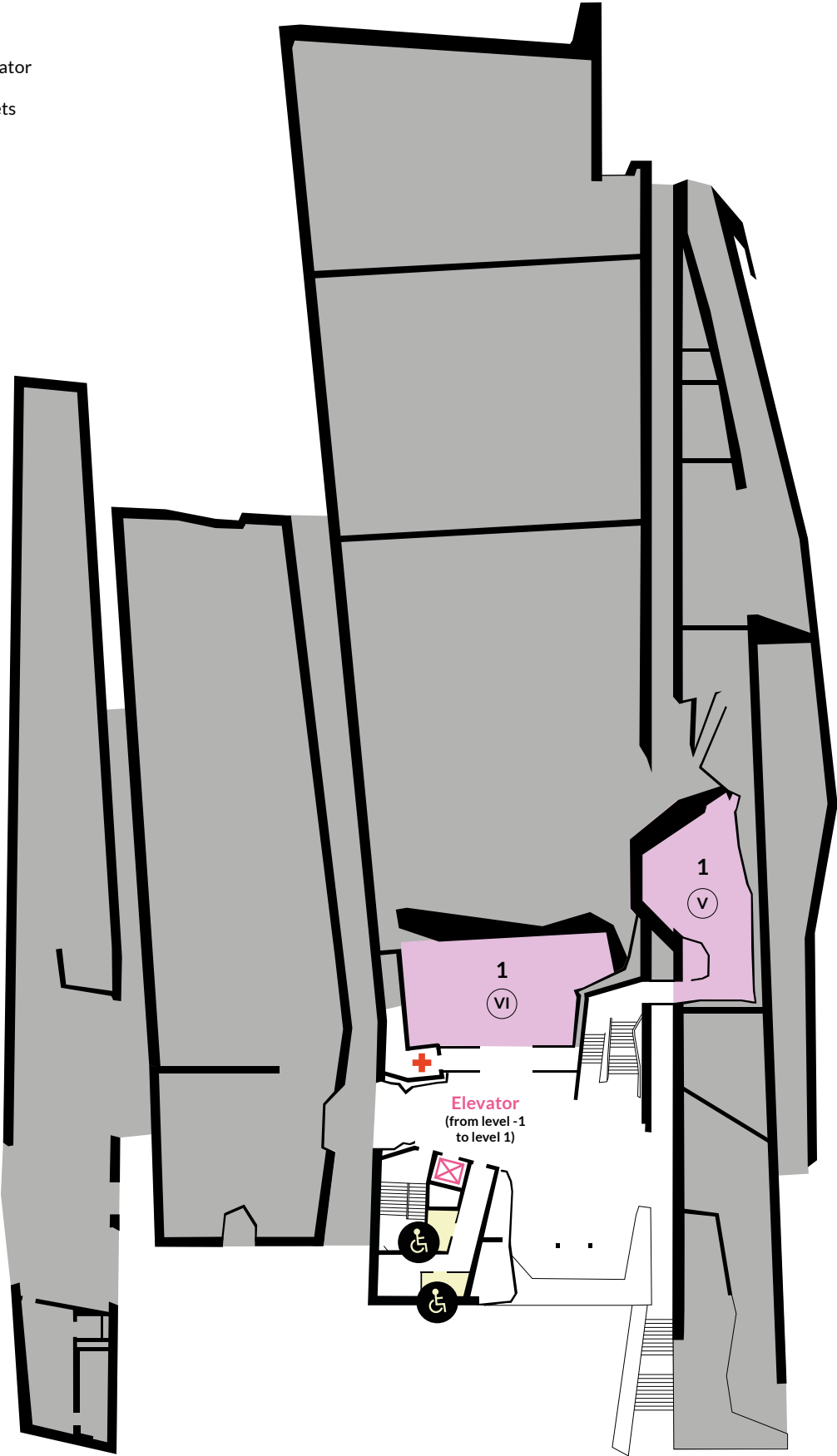
